



Dumbleyung Swimming Pool Receives \$1.6M State Government Funding Boost

The State Government has committed \$1.6M in Community Sporting and Recreation Facilities Funding (CSRFF) towards the redevelopment of the Dumbleyung Swimming Pool.

The Shire of Dumbleyung received formal Minister for Sport & Recreation notification confirming this important grant funding commitment earlier today.

Given the total project cost is estimated to be \$5.4M, this \$1.6M financial commitment from the State Government will go a long way towards bringing this important project into fruition.

The Shire of Dumbleyung now awaits the outcomes of its Federal Government Growing Regions Funding application to clarify whether any other additional grant funding assistance will be forthcoming.

In the meantime, further detailed design work on a redeveloped Dumbleyung Swimming Pool is being progressed towards completion and full project readiness.

Shire President Amy Knight said, *'This \$1.6M State Government CSRFF grant funding announcement is a wonderful outcome for our community. I would like to sincerely thank the Minister for Sport & Recreation and the State Government for their significant funding support.'*
