Positively influence physical and mental health




### Community

### 3. Eligibility

Ausgold accepts applications from all community groups and organisations. Applications for donations and/or sponsorships will not be considered where:

- an initiative solely benefits one individual
- organisations or individuals are aimed at making a profit
- initiatives or events are for political or religious purposes
- organisations request funding to produce advertising and promotional materials only
- applications request funding to cover wages, salaries, travel or payments to individuals
- applications are for projects that have started or are completed
- the initiatives or events are not aligned with Ausgold's values
- initiatives or events do not provide benefit to the community in the categories provided in Section 2
- applications are from organisations that are unable to provide a Tax Invoice and an ABN.

### 4. Application Requirements

We invite community members to complete the Ausgold Community Investment Application. All eligible applications will be reviewed and assessed by members of Ausgold's executive management team at the end of each quarter.
